Parent/Guardian Permission for Sensitive Issues Activities

In order to be responsive to girls' needs and interests, some Girl Scout activities focus on subjects that may be considered sensitive or controversial. There is no definitive list of these subjects. In general, sensitive issues may include religious beliefs, human sexuality, cultural and family values, eating disorders, AIDS, sexually transmitted diseases, substance abuse, child abuse, suicide, and/or teen pregnancy. These are issues that all children think and/or talk about at one time or another. The Girl Scout program helps girls to make informed, responsible decisions about their own well-being, as well as instills a sense of awareness of and appreciation for individual differences through positive interactions. Girl Scouts of the USA provides Girl Scout leaders and program providers with guidelines for discussion of sensitive issues in *Volunteer Essentials*, a nationally consistent Girl Scout resource of safety guidelines and program standards. The leader/advisor's role in these discussions is as a caring adult who can help girls acquire their own knowledge in a supportive atmosphere, and not as an advocate for any particular position.

Parent/guardian permission is required any time sensitive issues are the basis for a planned Girl Scout activity. By providing permission for your child to discuss topics of a sensitive nature, you will be allowing a healthy interaction that will hopefully allow your child to gain the confidence needed to come to you in the future when she is in need of your support and guidance.
