Complete the five steps to earn your Game Visionary Badge.

- 1. **Break the ice:** Play trivia bingo with your family or friends. Everyone has at least 10 interesting facts about themselves. Gather your family or friends and have everyone come up with 10 interesting facts about themselves and submit those facts to you, the game's spokesperson. Then have everyone make a bingo sheet; a five by five grid with one name per square. Then bring everyone together, this can be done virtually, and play bingo by reading off the characteristics until someone gets BINGO!
- 2. **Imagine all the world's a board:** Watch the attached video to learn how to make an outdoor checkers game.
- 3. **Create a physical challenge:** Think about what were some of your favorite games to play as a kid. Pick two or three of those games and combine them to make a new games. Your new game should be something that would be more challenging than the original, something you think would be cool to play. You can do this by adding new rules, an obstacle, or even set it to music.
- 4. **Get puzzled:** Girl Scouts and Girl Guides have been playing Wide Games for a long time. Learn about wide games, how to plan one, and how to write one. Then make your own. Scroll down on this <u>website</u> till you get to the section about wide games for more information and tips.
- 5. **Make an ultra scavenger hunt:** Complete a super alphabet hunt. First, make a limit for the area that you can search, it could be as big as your neighborhood, or as small as a single room. Then take a digital photo of between 50 and 100 things and describe it in a caption with as many words as you can with the first letter of that thing. For Instance if

you see a bird you could say beautiful brown bird beside the barn. Do this challenge with at least one other person. At the end see who has the most descriptive captions for each photo.
