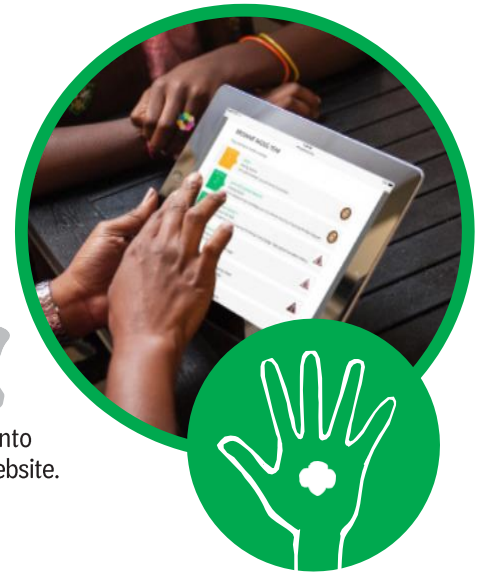
Volunteer Essentials:

Your Girl Scout volunteer guidebook. It contains all of the policies and procedures that are put into place by GSUSA and GSCWM. This document is revised every year, and is made available on our website.

WHERE TO FIND:

- Go to www.gscwm.org.
- Click MYGS/VTK on the top right of the page.
- Click Volunteer Toolkit.
- Enter or create a user name and password.
- Click Volunteer Toolkit again
- Click the resources tab at the top of the screen

- Go to www.gscwm.org.
- Click FORMS at the top of the page.
- On the Forms page, type in the words “Volunteer Essentials” in the Keyword Search Bar.
- The Volunteer Essentials PDF will be one of your options.

Safety Activity Checkpoints:

When preparing for any activity with girls, always begin with the Safety Activity Checkpoints written specifically for that particular activity.

WHERE TO FIND:

- Go to www.gscwm.org. Click RESOURCES on the top of the page.
- Click Adult Learning/Training on the left side of the page.
- Next, SAFETY ACTIVITY CHECKPOINTS comes up as an option on the left of the page. Click that. Scroll down to find the link to Safety Activity Checkpoints. Or find Safety Activity Checkpoints on the RESOURCES tab of your Volunteer Toolkit.
