Camp Director & Assistant Director

Must be at least 25 years of age and have two years of experience or take camp director training. Plans and directs all camp operations with primary consideration of camper health & safety, delivery of the Girl Scout Leadership Experience in a fun and challenging outdoor environment, budget constraints, and special features of the particular camp. The assistant director works hand-in-hand with the director and needs to be ready and able to step in when the camp director is off-duty or out of camp.

Day Camp Program Specialist

Coordinate, develop, and deliver the Girl Scout Leadership Experience through outdoor/camp activities that provide progressive learning opportunities for campers. Includes responsibility for arts & crafts, sports, and nature activities.

Day Camp Unit/Bus Counselor

Works directly with campers, encouraging and supporting them in planning, coordinating and implementing daily unit activities that align with the Girl Scout Leadership Experience. Ride the bus to and from camp. Supervise campers on the bus and begin the fun that will continue through the day at camp.

Unit Counselor

Works directly with campers, encouraging and supporting them in planning, coordinating and implementing daily unit activities that align with the Girl Scout Leadership Experience.

Resident Camp Unit Leader

Works directly with campers, taking the lead in encouraging and supporting them in planning, coordinating and implementing daily unit activities that align with the Girl Scout Leadership Experience.

Health Specialist

Must be at least 18 years of age. Registered nurse preferred; nurse practitioner, EMT, Wilderness First Responder, LPN, or certified First Aid/CPR also considered. Responsible for the general health & safety of campers and staff. Ensure compliance with COVID-19 requirements.

Kitchen Assistant

Assists the Food Service Supervisor in preparing meals, maintaining the kitchen and dining hall, and complying with health and safety standards.

Pool Manager (Camp Lewis Perkins Day Camp)

Must be at least 21 years of age. Must have current Red Cross Lifeguard Certification, Red Cross First Aid, and CPR for the Professional Rescuer. Manages and supervises all activity within and near the pool.

Pool Lifeguard/Counselor

Must have current Red Cross Lifeguard Certification, Red Cross First Aid, and CPR for the Professional Rescuer. Works with the Pool Manager to manage and supervise all activity within and near the pool.

Resident Camp Arts & Crafts Specialist

Coordinate, develop, and deliver high-quality outdoor/camp arts & crafts activities that provide progressive learning opportunities for campers and align with the Girl Scout Leadership Experience.

Resident Camp Program Director

Coordinate, develop, and deliver the Girl Scout Leadership Experience through outdoor/camp activities that provide progressive learning opportunities for campers. Includes responsibility for sports, and nature activities.

Teen Program Coordinator

Deliver a leadership program for teen girls that encourages and supports them in planning, coordinating, and implementing program opportunities that align with the Girl Scout Leadership Experience.

Waterfront Director

Must be at least 21 years of age. Must have current Red Cross Lifeguard Certification, Red Cross First Aid, and CPR for the Professional Rescuer. Manages and supervises all activity within and near the waterfront.

Waterfront Specialist/Lifeguard

Must have current Red Cross Lifeguard Certification, Red Cross First Aid, and CPR for the Professional Rescuer. Works with the waterfront director to manage and supervise all activity within and near the waterfront.
