ACA Accreditation and Safety Regulations

The American Camp Association, or ACA, is the only accrediting body for recreational camps in the United States. ACA's accreditation standards focus on health, safety, and risk management, and are used as benchmarks by government entities. ACA accreditation provides public evidence of a camp's commitment to the well-being of campers and staff.



Camp Bonnie Brae, Camp Green Eyrie, and Camp Lewis Perkins are fully accredited ACA Camps. GSCWM submits annual reports to ACA for review and each camp receives an on-site evaluation from ACA representatives every three years, with our most recent visits happening during the summer of 2023. In addition to maintaining accreditation status, GSCWM staff utilize ACA trainings and research to develop exciting camp programs, maintain up-to-date staffing policies, and uphold industry best practices for participant health & safety. Although Camp Laurel Wood has not gone through the ACA accreditation process, our camp staff maintain the same ACA standards.

In addition to the safety guidelines outlined by ACA and GSUSA, all GSCWM camps comply with Massachusetts Department of Public Health regulations and are licensed by the local board of health.

Camp Staff

GSCWM selects staff based on maturity, program skills, experience, and ability to serve as role models. Day camp staff members are at least 16 years old, with leadership staff who are at least 21. Overnight camp staff are at least 18 or graduated from high school. Some select overnight staff positions are filled by staff who are at least 16. Overnight leadership staff are at least 21 and director teams are at least 25 per ACA and Massachusetts state standards. Camp staff attend intensive pre-camp training before the summer camp season to fully immerse themselves in their roles and prepare for campers. Staff members who supervise activities at the waterfront, challenge course, archery, and other specific program areas receive additional training and certifications. GSCWM conducts thorough staff criminal background (CORI) and sexual offender (SORI) checks. In accordance with the Massachusetts Department of Public Health and licensing by the local board of health, you have the right to request proof of background checks, camp healthcare policies, discipline policies as well as policies for filing grievances.



Campers with Individual Accommodations

GSCWM wants all girls to have the opportunity for a great camp experience. Campers who need individual accommodations can have a positive camp experience when these needs are disclosed to GSCWM camp staff prior to camp. If your camper requires accommodations for medical, physical, emotional, developmental, or social needs, please contact the GSCWM Program Manager, Jessica Gonzalez, at jgonzalez@gscwm.org or by phone at 413-584-2602 to discuss whether or not GSCWM camps can support your camper's specific needs before registering for camp.

Registration and Membership

Registration for summer 2026 opens on January 14, 2026. GSCWM uses an online platform called CampDoc to process camp registrations and camper health information. Once camp registration is open, click the registration link on the <u>summer camp page</u> at <u>www.gscwm.org</u> to get started.

Girl Scout camp is open to all girls - no prior Girl Scout experience needed to attend! Non-members have an additional \$55 fee for camp which also includes all membership benefits through Sept, 2026.

Full payment of the camp registration fee is due by June 10, 2026. After that date, full payment is due at the time of registration. If you are registering and applying for financial aid funds after June 10, the \$75 deposit is due at the time of registration and someone from GSCWM will contact you to complete the payment process.

All campers will receive a GSCWM Summer Camp t-shirt with camp registration.

Refunds and Transfers

To reschedule, transfer, or cancel your summer camp registration, please email <u>info@gscwm.org</u>, or submit a request in your Camp Doc account.

Please submit transfer requests no later than two weeks before your camp session.

Please submit cancellation requests no later than four weeks before your camp session for a refund. You will receive a refund minus the initial, non-refundable \$75 deposit. Refunds will not be given for registrations that are canceled within four weeks of a program, or if a member doesn't attend the camp session. Pro-rated refunds are not given if a member doesn't attend the full program.

In some cases, a partial or full refund may be granted for medical emergencies. In this case, notification of absence must be given, accompanied by a physician's note and written request within two weeks of the program.

In order to provide an effective and engaging program, GSCWM must have a minimum of 5 participants enrolled. If your program does not meet the minimum number of participants, you will receive an email with details on how to transfer your camper to another available session, or receive a refund of your session costs. Decisions regarding low enrollment programs will be made four weeks prior to the session start date. This minimum number of participants applies to both day & overnight camp programming

Waitlists

Many of our camp programs fill up fast and we recommend you register as early as possible. If the program your camper wants to attend is full, you may join the waitlist. A deposit or program fee is not required until your camper is removed from the waitlist. We are unable to predict when or if your camper will be removed from the waitlist. Waitlisted campers who do not have other registrations are encouraged to register for an open program to guarantee that they will be able to attend camp. You will receive an email from CampDoc informing you if you have been removed from the waitlist. The cost of the camp program will be added to your account and be due at that time.

Food at Day Camp

Campers attending day camp bring their own lunch and snacks each day. Additional snacks are provided by camp as needed.

Bus Stops

Busing is available for \$100 a week to and from Camp Green Eyrie and Camp Laurel Wood. Bus stops for both camps change weekly to accommodate campers from different areas, so it is important to review the bus schedule available on GSCWM's website. We are unable to add any additional bus stop locations.

After Care: Pick-up any time between 4:15 PM and 5:30 PM, \$75 per week.

No refund or discount for single days or late/early drop off on single days. No bussing is available for extended care hours.


Food at Overnight Camp

Counselor in Training (CIT II)

7/5/2026-7/24/2026 / Session 2A / \$700

The second part of the Counselor-In-Training program is for girls who have completed CIT I and are entering grade 11 and up. It allows you to learn the "ins and outs" of Camp Bonnie Brae as you dig deeper into leadership practices and the steps necessary to create a safe community for campers.
