Community Service Bar

When you earn this award, you are making a difference in your community for a cause you care about—and practicing the values of the Girl Scout Law.

It's easy to earn the Community Service Bar. Here's how:

- 1 Choose a cause and an organization you'd like to help.
- 2 Obtain instruction about the volunteer work you'll be doing.
- 3 Receive advance approval from the council by emailing the [Community Service Bar Application](#) to info@gscwm.org.
- 4 Once approved, complete at least 20 hours of service to earn the bar.
- 5 Use the helpful [Progress Tracking Sheet](#) and have your approved organization sign off on your hard work. Take the signed form to the council shop of your choice to purchase your service bar.



Service to Girl Scouting Bar

When you earn this award, you are making a difference for your sister Girl Scouts at Girl Scouts of Central and Western Massachusetts.

It's easy to earn the Service to Girl Scouting Bar. Here's how:

- 1 Choose a volunteer opportunity benefiting the Girl Scout Organization that appeals to you. This could be working with a local troop or in your Service Unit, or if you are looking to volunteer at the council level with opportunities such as making improvements to camp facilities and properties, please reach out to info@gscwm.org.
- 2 Complete at least 20 hours of service to earn the bar.
- 3 Use our helpful [Progress Tracking Sheet](#) and have your council contact sign off on your hard work. Take the signed form to the council shop of your choice to purchase your Service to Girl Scouting Bar.
